DEATHS.

In Beaver Meadow (Hamilton,) Sept. 16, ELISHA THOMPSON, aged 44 years. Also, Sept. 23, INEZ ELIZABETH, aged about 13 months, daughter of the above. Also, October 8, S. ELIJAH THOMPSON, aged 47 years. Also, October 27, AMOS THOMPSON, aged 64 years. Thus, from one family, three brothers and a daughter have been victims of the same disease—fever—which has destroyed the lives of very many in the same neighborhood, during the past season. The only survivors are the widow of Elisha Thompson [Sally Thompson, age 39] and a daughter in that family [Clara Thompson, age 6]. The loss to the community is deeply felt. They were good men, and therefore useful citizens. The funeral of the first three was attended Oct. 9, and the last Oct. 29, and discourses delivered by
