The funeral of Mrs. James Thresher, who died at the Little Falls Hospital, will be held from her late home on Van Buren street at 1:30 to-morrow afternoon, and from the Universalist church at 2 o'clock, the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton officiating. Mrs. Thresher's death followed an operation for rupture of the gall bladder. Her condition was favorable at first and it was thought she would recover, but unfortunate complications developed and resulted in her death. The deceased was born in Canada, but most of her life had been spent in Little Falls and in this village. Her maiden name was Elizabeth Saunders and she was 42 years of age. She was married to Mr. Thresher at Little Falls 21 years ago, and the couple had lived in this village since that time. Mrs. Thresher was a member of the Universalist Church. She was an earnest Christian woman, kind hearted and devoted to her home, and her untimely death has brought much sorrow to the community. Surviving besides the husband are a son, Harry, and a sister, Mrs. Henry Carter of St. Johnsville.
