FORT PLAIN—George H. Thurwood, 84, of 29 Center street, supervisor of the Town of Minden from 1934-1949, died Saturday afternoon in the Fort Plain Nursing Home where he had been a patient for two years. He was a lifelong resident of this community.

He was born March 16, 1881, in Nelliston, a son of George L. and Macy Farkell Thurwood. A member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, he had also been a member of Fort Plain Lodge, 433, F and A.M. for over 60 years. He was a clerk in the Fort Plain post office for 25 years and later was a representative of the Mohawk Valley Investment Corp. of Utica. He had been retired since 1949.

On Feb. 3, 1910, he was married to Mae Moyer in Fort Plain. She died Nov. 29, 1960.

He is survived by a daughter, Miss Evelyn Thurwood, Fort Plain and one niece, Mrs. John Crego, Utica.

Funeral services were held Tuesday at 2 p.m. at the Gray Funeral Home, with the Rev. Raymond Scott, pastor of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, officiating. Interment will be made in Fort Plain Cemetery in the spring. A Masonic service was held Monday at 8 p.m. in the Gray Funeral Home.
