H. H. Tibbitts dies; Former Supervisor

LITTLE FALLS—Henry H. Tibbitts, 90, Town of Danube supervisor from 1923 to 1933, died Saturday in Little Falls Hospital.

Born Jan. 15, 1875, in Newville, a son of Dr. William and Elizabeth Houpt Tibbitts, he attended Fairfield Seminary, the Rochester Business Institute and Clinton Liberal Institute, Fort Plain. He married Grace A. Schuyler, who died in 1934.

Mr. Tibbitts was also Danube town clerk for several years, clerk of the Herkimer County Compensation Board, and operated a dairy farm. He was a member of Nowadaga Grange.

Surviving are three sons, Morton, of Newville; Gerald, of Salisbury Center; Kenneth, of Newville; six grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Rev. Robert Sterling, Universalist Church pastor, conducted services 2 p.m. today from the Chapman Funeral Home, with burial in Houpt Cemetery, Newville.
