MOTHER OF PAUL N. FARNHAM DIES

Mrs. Elizabeth F. Tice Was Native of Vermont—
Resided in St. Johnsbury Until Few Years Ago

Mrs. Elizabeth Farnham Tice, widow of George C. Tice, of 18½ Nelson Street, died Tuesday afternoon in a local nursing home. She was born in Ryegate, Vt., 73 years ago and had resided in Auburn about three and one-half years.
