John Tice passed away quite suddenly at his home in Schuyler Lake, Monday at 5 p.m. He had been ill only a few days with pneumonia.

He was born in that town seventy-six years ago, and lived there his entire life.

His wife [Frances Duell Tice] died last February, and since that time he had lived alone, working every day for the neighbors. His son, Louis, and wife were sent for, and they came at once, caring for him until he died.

He was the last of a large family, and leaves the one son mentioned besides several nieces and nephews. His funeral was held Wednesday at his late home, the Rev. Charles Kramer [Universalist] officiating.

Mr. Tice will be greatly missed in town where he was a very familiar figure on the street for many years, always a kind and congenial neighbor and friend, and ready to help anyone whenever he could.—Our Schuyler Lake Reporter.
