Mrs. Mary Tice, wife of Armenus [Armenius] Tice, died Wednesday November 27th, aged 82 years. Mr. and Mrs. Tice have spent nearly all their life about one mile out of the village on the east side of the lake. On account of ill health they moved to Snowden with their son Antone, where Mrs. Tice died. Mrs. Tice was the mother of four children, who survive her, two sons, Antone and John, and two daughters, Mrs. Catherine Spohnburgh of Richfield Springs, and Mrs. Charles Spohnburgh of this place. Her husband is very feeble and nearly blind. The funeral was held from the house on Friday, conducted by the Rev. S. [Samuel] R. Ward [Universalist] of Richfield Springs; interment in the village cemetery.
