DIED, In Concord, August 20, LUCINDA, in the 15th year of her age. Also, August 23, SALLY, in the 18th year of her age. Also, Sept. 2, ANN ELIZA, in the 13th year of her age. The above were all daughters of Thomas D. Tiffany. On the 10th of September, 1843, Br. Tiffany lost his wife, and in April last his eldest daughter was called away by death. Thus in the space of one year he has been called to mourn the departure of five of the members of his family; but he and all that mourn have one unfailing source of consolation found in that faith that supported our departed sisters...and never was a more complete victory over death than in the instances above named...
