Mr. Tilyou was a Republican leader of the town and a trusted advisor of Owen D. Young.

There survives one son William of Schenectady. The funeral will be held Friday afternoon at 2:30 standard time from the home. Rev. Rufus H. Dix, pastor of the Universalist church of Fort Plain, will officiate. Burial will be in the Vana Hornesville cemetery.
