MRS. TIMMERMAN TAKEN BY DEATH  
Well Known Fort Plain Woman Dies at Son's Home in Voorheesville

FORT PLAIN—Emma Wilkes Timmerman, 78, widow of Manley E. Timmerman, died Wednesday at the home of her son, Ray Timmerman, Voorheesville, where she had been visiting for two weeks, from an illness of bronchial pneumonia.

Mrs. Timmerman was born September 22, 1856 in the Fords Bush section of this town and had always lived in this vicinity. For the past 15 years she had been a resident of Fort Plain. Mrs. Timmerman was a member of the Universalist Church, Otsquago Chapter, O.E.S., Fort Plain Chapter, D.A.R., and Fort Plain Unit, 554, American Legion Auxiliary. The remains were brought to her home, Willett Street, Wednesday night.

The survivors are three sons, Ray Timmerman, Voorheesville, and Clare and Harold Timmerman, Fort Plain. The funeral will be held Friday at 2:30 p.m. at the home, Rev. Gustav[e] Ulrich, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist church, officiating. Interment will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
