OLD RESIDENT PASSES AWAY IN FORT PLAIN
Death Calls Manley E. Timmerman After Rather Long Illness

FORT PLAIN—Manley E. Timmerman, 78, a well known resident of Fort Plain died at his home, Willett street, Saturday, after having been in poor health for some time. Mr. Timmerman had been in a hospital in Amsterdam for several weeks, but had been at his home here for the past two months. He was a lifelong resident of this town and for many years conducted a farm in the Dutchtown section. He moved to Fort Plain a number of years ago upon retiring from farm work. Mr. Timmerman was a member of Fort Plain Masonic Lodge, 433. He was a son of the late David P. and Charlotte Elwood Timmerman, and was born July 26, 1851. He is survived by his wife [Emma E. Wilkes Timmerman], and three sons, Ray Timmerman of Albany, Clare and Harold Timmerman of Fort Plain. The funeral (Masonic) will be held Tuesday at 2 P.M. from his home, Rev. Rufus H. Dix, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist church, officiating. The burial will be made in Fort Plain.
