Her husband was the youngest and last surviving son of the late Simeon Tingue, years ago a well known merchant of this village, and he was born in this village and removed to Baltimore about 1865. He returned to Fort Plain about 1867 and lived here two years, since which time his visits here have been very infrequent.
