—Anson Titus, the inventor of the Titus plows died the 22d inst. of paralysis, aged 74 years. His residence for nearly a half century was Phelps, Ontario county. His father was Billy Titus, an early pioneer in the development of the iron ore beds of Hanover and Paris. Mr. Titus was born in Forge Hollow, in Marshall, Oneida county. He was an active Universalist layman, as his father was before. He was the father of Rev. Anson Titus, jr., of Weymouth, Mass.
