—The death of Mrs. Mercy Ann Todd occurred suddenly at her home, 750 River street, shortly after 6 o'clock this morning. Mrs. Todd, though she had been in ill health for about a year, rose shortly after 5 o'clock this morning and commenced her usual household duties. She was suddenly seized with a violent hemorrhage of the lungs. Word was hastily sent to Dr. H. E. DeFreest, but Mrs. Todd died before the physician's arrival. She was about sixty-three years of age and had resided in the upper section of the city for the last fifty years. She was a member of the Universalist Church and was well known and respected. She was the widow of Joseph Henry Todd, who was a well known Trojan. She is survived by a sister, Miss Almyne Wilmarth, and a brother, Alfred Todd [sic].
