Death of Esteemed Resident of Canandaigua After Long Illness

Canandaigua, Dec. 27—At 5:10 o'clock this morning Mrs. Emma Trafton, wife of Henry C. Trafton, who resides at No. 136 Bristol street, passed away at the family residence after a long illness.

Mrs. Trafton was born at Sharron Center, O., fifty-nine years ago and resided there until her marriage with Henry C. Trafton on February 14, 1876, when Mr. and Mrs. Trafton came to the town of Bristol. They resided in that township for many years, but some years ago came to this village, where they have continued to reside in a house which they erected in Bristol street.

Mrs. Trafton leaves her husband, two daughters, Miss Minnie L. Trafton, of this village, and Mrs. James Cameron, of Scottsville, N.Y.; a brother, Clarence C. Crane, of Sharron Center, O., and a sister, Mrs. D. Y. Bell, of Berkeley, Cal.

The funeral services will be held from the family residence on Monday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, with Rev. E. P. Wood, pastor of the Universalist congregation, officiating. Interment will be made Woodlawn cemetery here.
