HENRY CLAY TRAFTON

Canandaigua, June 8.—Henry Clay Trafton died at his residence in Bristol street at 7:15 o'clock last evening. He was 68 years old. He was born in Bristol in 1849 and lived there the greater part of his life, coming to this city some years ago and making his home here since. He was born on the same farm in Bristol where three generations of his family were born, his father, himself and his children. The farm is now owned by Mrs. Minnie T. Lee, a daughter of Mr. Trafton, who lives at the Trafton home in this city. He also leaves another daughter, Mrs. James Cameron, of Scottsville, and four grandsons. Mr. Trafton's mother died at a great age only about six months ago. His wife [Emma Crane] died four years ago.

The funeral will be held at the late residence Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, with Rev. George W. Scudder, Universalist pastor at Victor, officiating. Burial will be in Woodlawn cemetery here.
