Obituary

Louisa Hill was born in the town of Reading, Schuyler Co., N.Y., May 8th, 1825, and died at the farm home about one mile west of Cohocton, Jan. 20, 1906. She was the only daughter of S. Morris and Jerusha Hill, and removed with her parents from Gorham, Ontario Co., to Cohocton in April 1846 or 7, and located on the farm where she died.

She was married to I. [Ira] Marvin Tripp, May 14, 1850. Her only daughter, Julia E. Shoultice and two granddaughters, Lena and Anna, are the only surviving members of her family.

Deceased had been a faithful and steadfast helpmeet, and a loving mother, and will be greatly missed in the home which has so long known her presence.

The funeral services were held from the Universalist church in Cohocton, and in the absence of the pastor, Rev. Clara Morgan, were conducted by the Rev. Chas. E. Petty [also a Universalist] of Hornellsville. She was laid to rest in Maple View cemetery, this village, by the side of her husband who died seven years ago.
