F. A. Truex Dies at 54; Was Painter

Schuyler Lake—Francis A. Truex, 54, a local painter and paperhanger, died yesterday in his home.

He was born in Allentown, Pa., the son of Will C. and Blanche Plummer Truex. They moved to Sandy Creek when he was two years old. He attended schools there. He married Beatrice Cummings of Sandy Creek in 1932, in Pulaski. They moved here in 1939.

He leaves his wife; two sons, Francis P., West Exeter and James W., Schuyler Lake; a daughter Rebecca Truex, at home; his mother, Mrs. Blanche Miller, Schuyler Lake; two sisters, Miss Irene Truex, Binghamton, and Mrs. Katherine Perkins, Richfield Springs; three brothers, Will Truex, West Winfield, Robert Taylor, Mt. Vision, and George Taylor, Schuyler Lake.
