HARRY TUCKER, 57, FREEVILLE, DIES
Was Moderator of McLean Universalist Church

Harry M. [H.] Tucker, 57, a lifelong resident of Freeville and Dryden, died early Sunday morning at his home in Freeville following several months' illness.
