DEATH OF LANDLORD TYLER.

The Proprietor of the Central Hotel Passed Away This Morning

J. Llewellyn Tyler, who has been proprietor of the Central hotel in State street for the past twelve years, died at that hostelry this morning at 4:30 o'clock after a few weeks sickness. For some time past, Mr. Tyler has not been in the best of health, and two weeks ago he was taken with congestion of the brain. The deceased was born in the town of Aurelius fifty three years ago and has resided in Cayuga county the greater part of his life. He is well known and has hosts of friends throughout the county who will be pained to hear of his death. He is a son of Loren [Loron] Tyler, of Sennett, one of the oldest residents of this county. He leaves a wife [Helen Anna (Pierce) Tyler], one sister, Mrs. W. L. Soule¹ of Sennett, and a brother George L. Tyler of this city. The deceased was a popular member of Logan Tribe of Red Men and also a member of the Knights of Honor. The funeral will take place from the hotel parlors Thursday afternoon at 4 o'clock. Rev. J. M. Bartholomew, pastor of the Universalist church, will conduct the service. The interment will be in held in Fort Hill cemetery.
