MRS. F. PEARL UNDERWOOD DIES AT 82

Mrs. F. Pearl Underwood, 82, of the Jefferson county home, widow of William B. Underwood of Adams and a former resident of that village, died at 8:24 Saturday morning in the Mercy hospital, where she had been a patient since August. Mrs. Underwood, who had lived at the county home since September, 1967, formerly lived at an adult home on Morrison street.

The funeral was held this morning at 11 at the Northam & Fox funeral home. Rev. Blaine F. Hartford, pastor of the All Souls Universalist church, officiated. Burial was in Rural cemetery, Adams.

A daughter, Miss Olive Underwood of North Orchard street, survives.

Mrs. Underwood was born Aug. 29, 1886, in Canada, a daughter of William and Olive Shook Denny. She moved to Adams in early life and on May 29, 1905. was married to William B. Underwood of that village in Honeyville.

Mr. and Mrs. Underwood lived at Adams thereafter. Mr. Underwood died in the House of the Good Samaritan March 15, 1943, at the age of 58. He was an automobile salesman.
