Obsequies.

The funeral of ZENAS T. UTMAN, which occurred from his late residence, No. 25 North Transit street, yesterday afternoon, at 3 o'clock, was very largely attended by his many friends in this city, and was a most impressive and solemn affair. Davis, formerly pastor of the Universalist church, of which deceased was a member.
