Auburn—Mrs. Nina Bedell Vail, widow of the Rev. Charles H. Vail, died yesterday (May 28, 1947) in her home, 25 Court Street.

She was a native of Geneva and had lived in Auburn since 1922, when her husband became pastor of the First Universalist Church. He died here in 1924.

Mrs. Vail was a graduate of St. Lawrence University, Canton, and was a member of the First Universalist Church, Auburn, and of its Kings Daughters Society, and of the WTCU.

Her husband was pastor of Universalist churches in Albion and St. Paul, Minn., for many years. He came to Auburn from the latter city.

Mrs. Vail is survived by a sister, Mrs. Florence T. E. Bevier, Auburn; three nieces, one being Mrs. Charles A. June, Auburn; and two nephews.

The funeral will be at 2 p.m. Saturday in the chapel of Lester E. Brew, 48 South street, Auburn, with the Rev. Earl N. Engle, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. Burial in Tully.
