The death of Mrs. T. Lovisa Vail, widow of Frank A. Vail, occurred Thursday at the home of her son, Rev. Charles H. Vail, pastor of the Pullman [Memorial Universalist] church, aged 82 years. She was born in Brookfield, N.Y., January 4, 1833. For the greater part of her life she was a resident of Tully, N.Y., where in 1854 she became the wife of Frank A. Vail. Eight years ago she and her husband, whose death occurred about two years ago [on 8 Nov 1912], came to Albion and have since lived with her son. Mrs. Vail leaves only her son. The funeral was held from the parsonage, Saturday afternoon, Rev. Arthur W. Grose officiating. The body will be taken to Tully, N.Y., where a burial service was held Sunday.
