FRANK VAN ALLEN

Frank Van Allen died at 3 o'clock Monday morning at his home on Elm street. He had been in poor health for some time but death came unexpectedly. He was born June 2, 1875, in Lassellsville, son of Hoffman and Delia Stahl Van Allen. He was married to Ida Richards in St. Johnsville on December 24, 1904, and had resided in this village for the past 20 years. At one time he was employed by Alfred Dolge and later by Daniel Green Co., and J. Breckwoldt and Son, but he had not been employed steadily recently due to ill health. He is survived by the widow; one son, Clyde of Little Falls; four daughters, Mrs. Thomas B. Griffith, Mrs. Edward Crane and Mrs. Charles Hewitt of this village and Mrs. Harold Smith of Gloversville; and seven grandchildren. The funeral services will be held from the home Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the local Universalist church officiating.
