Irving Van Alstyne, 57, died Sunday evening at his home at Fort Plain RD 1, after a long illness. Born Dec. 19, 1901, in Fort Plain, he was the son of Edwin and Clara Nestle Van Alstyne. He had been a resident of Fort Plain all his life until moving to Fort Plain RD 1 a year ago. Mr. Van Alstyne, a general building contractor, married the former Grace Bisnett, Syracuse, who survives, on April 23, 1920. He was a member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, Fort Plain, and the Fraternal Order of Eagles, Johnstown.

Funeral services were held yesterday at 2 p.m. from the Swartz funeral home, Fort Plain, with the Rev. Raymond M. Scott, pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. Burial was made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
