Death of Abram Van Camp, Aged 90 Years

Fort Plain, April 2.—Abram Van Camp, one of the oldest and most esteemed residents of this village, died early this morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. L. M. [Celistia, wife of Lucius Morelle] Canfield, aged 90 years. He had been (in poor health?) for a long time, and during the past two weeks his condition was considered critical.
