The following is from the Saturday Globe, published at Utica, June 21: "The death of Daniel C. Van Camp, an old and respected resident of Fort Plain, occurred at his home, Wednesday morning, at 6 o'clock. He was 65 years old. He leaves a widow [Almira Sanders Van Camp] and six children to mourn his loss. The children are Mrs. J. O. [Ella] Snell, Malen Van Camp, Cornelius D. Van Camp, Mrs. F. C. [Elizabeth] Fineout, Mrs. Frank G. [Anna] Bartlett, of this village; Mrs. W. L. Palmer, of Port Chester, N.Y. Mr. Van Camp was an active business man of this village for many years, but was compelled to retire by failing health. His funeral occurred from the house this morning at 10 o'clock, Rev. E. [Edwin A. Perry [Universalist] officiating. Interment took place in the Fort Plain Cemetery. The funeral was attended by the members of the Fire Department, of which Mr. Van Camp was, for many years, an active member."
