MRS. VAN CAMP FUNERAL RITES AT FORT PLAIN

FORT PLAIN, Jan. 29.—Mrs. Frances M. Van Camp, 86, died at the home of her daughter-in-law Mrs. Amelia Van Camp, Friday night. She was the widow of James Van Camp and had been in failing health for some time.

Mrs. Van Camp was born November 4, 1858 in Springfield Center, Otsego County, the daughter of James and Eliza A. Wood Manzer, and had been a resident of Fort Plain for more than 50 years. She was a member of the Universalist Church.

The survivors are the daughter-in-law, one sister, Mrs. Seymour Seeley, Syracuse, nine grandchildren: Ivan Van Camp, Norwich; Robert Hayes, Army; Walter Hayes, Marines; Mary Hayes, WAC; Mrs. Paul Morgan and Mrs. Stanley Morgan, Utica; Miss Frances Hayes, Texas; Mrs. James Shepherd and Mrs. Converse Boldt, East Syracuse; 11 great-grandchildren.
