MRS. O. L. VAN HORNE

The death of Mrs. Mabelle A. Van Horne, wife of Attorney Orange L. Van Horne of this village, occurred Sunday evening at 8 o'clock at the Mary Imogene Bassett Hospital where she had been a patient since Friday. She was 74 years of age.

Mrs. Van Horne was born in Schuyler Lake on January 12, 1883, a daughter of the late William and Addie (Yates) Rose. She graduated from Schuyler Lake School, and from the Greeley School of Oratory and Dramatic Arts in Boston. She spent a year with a dramatic company giving entertainments in and around New York City, and in the southern and southwestern states.

She was married to Mr. Van Horne on February 11, 1911 at Schuyler Lake. All their married life had been spent in Cooperstown, where her husband is senior member of the law firm of Van Horne and Feury.

Mrs. Van Horne was a member of the Schuyler Lake Universalist Church, and of the Cooperstown Woman's Club. She had been a member of the Advisory Board of the Criterion Club since it was organized many years ago.

She is survived by her husband; three cousins, former Otsego County Sheriff Don W. Rose of Cooperstown, David C. Rose of Endicott, and Robert B. Rose of Buffalo, Wyoming; and an aunt, Mrs. John Neeley of Mohawk.

Private funeral services were held Wednesday from her late residence on Chestnut Street, with the Rev. Kenneth F. Hardy, pastor of the First Baptist Church, officiating.
