Death of Daniel P. Van Liew

Another veteran of the civil war and a reliable citizen has been added to the list of those who have gone on before. Daniel P. Van Liew, a prominent farmer of the town of Fleming, died Saturday Dec. 8th at his home, after an illness of two months, from a valvular [sic] disease of the heart. He was for several years a citizen of Auburn, being engaged in the carpenter and building trade, but he afterwards removed to the farm in Fleming on which he has resided for nearly 20 years. He was born in the town of Scipio in 1839, and served in the war in the 75th N.Y. Infantry.

Funeral services were held at his late home Tuesday, Dec. 11, at 11 a.m. Rev. I. [Ora] M. Hilton [Universalist] of Auburn will officiate. Burial was at Sand Beach cemetery.

Besides a widow [Phebe Post Van Liew], one daughter, Miss Minnie, and one son, Elmer Van Liew, are left to mourn the loss.
