HENRY VAN VALKENBURGH

Henry Van Valkenburgh died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Waldvogel, in Little Falls, Nov. 27.

Mr. Van Valkenburgh was born in Sharon Sept. 12, 1854, a son of Stephen and Hannah Bellinger Van Valkenburgh. He married Nancy Rebecca Bellinger, who died 32 years ago. For many years he and his father conducted one of the largest farms in Schoharie county. He was the last of a family of six children.

Besides the daughter with whom he resided, he is survived by two other daughters, Mrs. Joseph Furlan of Cleveland, O., and Mrs. Frederick Radell of Utica; five grandchildren; one great-grandchild, several nieces and nephews.

The funeral was held Sunday with Rev. Howard Gilman, pastor of St. Paul's Universalist church, officiating. Interment was in Little Falls.
