Saturday, March 6, 1909. Cornelius Vasberg passed away at his home here, aged about 77 years. He had been feeble for some time, but had been about until a week previous to his death, the cause, of which was pneumonia, followed the grip. He was a quiet and unassuming man, honest and industrious. Of the family there remain his wife and her small nephew, Raymond Vasburg, who has lived with them from infancy. He also leaves one sister, Mrs. Jane Spencer of Canajoharie, and several nieces and nephews in that vicinity. One nephew, John Tice, resides here. The funeral was held from the late home Wednesday at 1 p.m., Rev. F. [Frank] C. Hokerk [Universalist] conducting the services.
