

[Veber, Lucius O.]

The funeral of Lucius O. Veber of Schuylers [sic] Lake was held at one o'clock Tuesday afternoon. Rev. S. R. Ward of Richfield Springs officiated, and the free masons had charge of the commitment services. A number of masons from Richfield Springs and Springfield Center lodges attended. Deceased had been prominent in masonic circles and was a member of Schuylers Lake lodge, F. and A. M., and of Richfield Springs chapter, R.A.M. In politics he was a steadfast republican from the founding of the party, and often held office in it. He was postmaster at Schuylers Lake many years. His religious belief was Universalism, in which faith he lived an exemplary life and died a peaceful, trustful death. His age was 63 years, and he is survived by a widow [Ellen Morey Veber] and one daughter, Mrs. Arthur [Jessie M.] Lidell. Interment was made in the Schuylers Lake cemetery.
