NORMAN VEDDER

Norman Vedder, 32 [42], a World War veteran, died at his home in the Dutchtown district, near here, Saturday afternoon [11 Mar] after a lingering illness of several months. He was the son of the late Willard and Anna Mosher Vedder, and on May 21, 1921, was married to Miss Edna Foster. Besides his wife he is survived by five children, George, Marion, Ernest, Edwin and Jessie Vedder.

Deceased was a member of the Herman Schumacher Post 291, American Legion, who had charge of the funeral, which was held at the home on Monday afternoon at 2, Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the local Universalist church officiating. Until spring the body was placed at the Dolgeville vault and then laid to rest in the Tuttle cemetery.
