Mrs. John B. Vibbard Dies

Lizzie Scott Vibbard, widow of John B. Vibbard, 391 Division Street, Amsterdam, died at 7:45 Saturday night at her home following a short illness.

She was born at Ft. Plain Feb. 19, 1869, the daughter of Barney and Nancy Catherine Yerdon Scott, and received her education at the Clinton Liberal Institute at Ft. Plain. She was married to Mr. Vibbard at Nelliston Oct. 19, 1892. He died Jan. 24, 1952.

Mrs. Vibbard helped to establish the Girl Scouts of Amsterdam and was a member of the original council of that organization. She was a member of the Universalist Church of Ft. Plain.

Survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Katherine Roarke, Amsterdam, and Mrs. Basil C. Gray, Wellesley Hills, Mass.; two grandchildren, and one brother, Charles Scott, Ft. Plain.

The funeral will be held at 2 this afternoon at the Johnson-Lindsay Funeral Home in Amsterdam. The Rev. Frank T. Rhoad will officiate. Burial will be in the Ft. Plain Cemetery.
