Howard H. Vickery

Howard H. Vickery, 76, a lifelong resident of Genesee County, died at 1:15 o'clock this afternoon at his home, No. 147 Bank street, of the effects of a stroke suffered yesterday.

Mr. Vickery was born at Darien on May 10, 1860, a son of the late Dr. S. N. and Jane Eliza Lombard Vickery. He had been a prominent farmer of this vicinity until his retirement about 13 years ago when he took up residence in Batavia.

Surviving are his wife, Cora Hitchcock Vickery, whom he married in Oakfield in 1893, a daughter, Mrs. James E. Norton of Batavia, several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at his late home Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in Reed Cemetery, Oakfield.
