SOUTH RUTLAND RESIDENT EXPIRES TUESDAY EVENING

He was well known in Copenhagen where he resided for a number of years. He has been a farmer the most of his life but at one time conducted a general store in South Rutland where he was born.

The funeral was held at his home Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed, pastor of the Universalist Church of Watertown, officiated. Burial was made in the South Champion cemetery.
