MRS. D. M. B. WALKER DEAD
Sister of Mrs. F. W. Betts Will be Buried To-morrow

The funeral of Mrs. Delphena¹ M. B. Walker, the wife of George B. Walker, who died Saturday morning, will be held at the family home at Onondaga Hill at 1 o'clock to-morrow afternoon. Rev. Dr. Frederick W. Betts, pastor of the First Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be at Onondaga Hill.

Mrs. Walker had been ill only a few days with pneumonia. She was a life-long resident of Onondaga Hill. She was the daughter of the late Welcome Browning [who died in 1897]. Besides her husband she is survived by two sons, Rev. Dr. George D. Walker, superintendent of the Universalist Church in New York State, and Warren Walker; one daughter, Mrs. L. C. Willson of this city; and two sisters, Mrs. F. H. [Janette] Case of Onondaga Hill and Mrs. [Mary] Betts, wife of Dr. Betts.
