Avery. Her attachment for her home, however, led her to apply for admission to the Home for the Friendless and a month ago she returned. Many years of her life were devoted to teaching. She was never married. The funeral services will be held at the home at 2:30 and from the First Universalist Church at 3 o'clock this afternoon. The Rev. Dr. [Asa] Saxe will officiate.
