ONEONTA WOMAN KILLED IN AUTO CRASH SUNDAY

Mrs. Charles C. Wallace, sixty years old, of No. 70 Dietz street, Oneonta, died at the Vassar Brothers hospital in Poughkeepsie at 11 o'clock Sunday night of injuries received Sunday afternoon when the Ford sedan in which she was riding with her husband and Mr. and Mrs. Fred Mueller, No. 30 Church street, Oneonta, crashed into two other automobiles about one and one-half miles south of the village of Highland.

Mr. Wallace, who is seventy years old, suffered a fractured jaw, a severely injured arm and also suffered from shock. He now is in the Vassar Brothers hospital in Poughkeepsie. Mr. and Mrs. Mueller escaped injury. The drivers of the two other machines were only slightly bruised or shaken up. The Wallace machine was wrecked.

Mrs. Wallace was the daughter of the Rev. and Mrs. George Adams, a Universalist minister, and was born in Killawog, Broome county. She was twice married, her first husband being Z. Jay Wallace, formerly of Morris, whom she married about twenty-five years ago. She married Charles C. Wallace of Oneonta about eight years ago [29 May 1917] in Utica and had lived in that city [Oneonta] since that time. She was a member of the Universalist church of Morris.
