MRS. EMORY WALRATH

Mrs. Lida Walrath, aged 65 years, wife of the late Emory Walrath of Freysbush, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Harry D. Bauder, in Freysbush, Monday morning at 5:25 o'clock after a short illness. Her death was a shock to the community as she was making rapid recovery after being stricken 10 days ago. Mrs. Walrath was born at Freysbush February 3, 1866, and was a daughter of the late Paul and Nancy Smith Iffland, and had been a resident of Freysburg practically all of her life. On April 28, 1888, she was united in marriage to Emory Walrath, who died February 27, 1912. She was a lovable mother, a woman of very kindly disposition. She was deeply devoted to her home and her family and a host of true friends mourn her loss. She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Harry D. Bauder, with whom she had made her home; one son, William E. Walrath, of Canajoharie; two sisters, Mrs. Frazier Fox of Syracuse, and Mrs. David Hotaling of Starkville; one brother, William Iffland of Freysbush; and a sister-in-law, Mrs. William C. House of Fort Plain; also three grandchildren, Mary, Robert, and Roseann Walrath of Canajoharie. The funeral services were held from the home Wednesday afternoon. Rev. Rufus H. Dix, pastor of the Universalist Church of Fort Plain officiated. The interment was made in Fort Plain Cemetery.
