DIED AT FORT PLAIN

Mrs. Alphonso Walrath, an Esteemed Resident, Summoned

Fort Plain, Jan. 4.—Mrs. Alphonzo Walrath died at her home on Lydius street, Saturday morning at 5:30 o'clock, aged 62 years. Deceased had been in failing health for a long time, but the evening previous to her death was considered by her near and dear friends as gradually improving from a recent attack. Her death removes another of the beloved and esteemed residents of Fort Plain, where she had resided all her life. She was a daughter of the late T. B. Farley, and the widow of Hon. Alphonzo Walrath. Her death brings sadness and sorrow to a larger circle of friends and acquaintances who have enjoyed her warm hospitality and many kindnesses. She was the mother of six children, all of whom survive: Maude, wife of E. [Edward] S. Crane of Syracuse, and Alton A., Jessie, Nettie, Hazel and Mary of Fort Plain. She is also survived by one sister, Mrs. Snell, and one brother, Theodore, of Fort Plain. The funeral will be held from her late home Tuesday at 2 p.m., Rev. J. L. Richards of the Universalist Church officiating.
