GEORGE RODNEY WARD DIES SUDDENLY

Little Falls—George Rodney Ward died suddenly at his home in Eatonbush, Town of Herkimer, yesterday. He had been ailing [for] some time from a heart condition, and suffered a severe attack Saturday while he was at the Little Falls milk station. He was attended by Dr. Harry Vickers who advised him to cease active work.

He was born Jan. 15, 1882, son of Dudley and Ella Bucklin Ward, early settlers of this vicinity. He resided all his life in the house where he was born. He was a director of the Little Falls Dairy Company, member of the Universalist church, and of the Shell's Bush Grange.

In 1907, he married Laura Mae Hughes, who survives with two daughters, Mrs. Lawrence Petrie, Gloversville, and Mrs. Glen Ricer, Top Notch road; three brothers, Walter, Shell's Bush, Arthur, East Herkimer, and Bela, Syracuse; two sisters, Mrs. Peter Bellinger, Fall Hill and Mrs. John Stafford, Indianapolis.

The funeral will be held at the home Thursday, the Rev. Howard Gilman, pastor, Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be made in Oak Hill Cemetery, Herkimer.
