CANAJOHARIE, Dec. 29—Ray Ward, 63, died yesterday afternoon [Dec. 28, 1950] at his home, 92 Reed St., following a long illness.

Mr. Ward was born in the Town of Minden, January 10, 1887, the son of Milton and Ida Van Slyke Ward. He lived in Canajoharie for the past 27 years and was an interior decorator. He was a member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah in Fort Plain.
