Joseph E. Washburn

Joseph E. Washburn, 71, native of Fort Plain, died Friday at 800 Hamilton Street, Schenectady, where he resided.

Mr. Washburn was found dead in bed in his third floor room in the morning by Charles Wallard, a roomer in the building. Coroner E. J. Seas, who stated death was due to natural causes, said Mr. Washburn probably died Friday.

He was born in Fort Plain, November 23, 1870, the son of Frank and Olive Green Washburn. He lived in Schenectady about 50 years and retired about 10 years ago from the General Electric Company. His wife, Mrs. Mary Matice Washburn, died several years ago.

The survivors are two brothers, Charles, Fort Plain, and Harry, Bronxville, and one sister, Miss Rexie Washburn, Johnstown.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Gray funeral home. The Rev. William A. Haney, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
