Macedon, Nov. 17—Miss Ada Watkins passed away Wednesday night at the home of her niece, Mrs. Fred [Katherine] Kemp. Miss Watkins had been in failing health for some time, but only confined to her bed for a few days. She was born in Victor Oct. 9, 1850, the daughter of the late Marshall and Caroline Watkins. After the death of her parents she resided at the home of her sister, Mrs. Homer [Emily Watkins] Bickford, until 1886 when she went to Michigan where she resided until about 12 years ago when she returned to Macedon. She leaves a sisterinlaw [sic] Mrs. Emma Lapham, besides her niece, Mrs. Kemp. Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon, Rev. John Bennett, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. The remains, accompanied by Mr. and Mrs. Fred Kemp, were taken to Adrian, Mich., for burial.
