—The death of William Watkins, an old and respected resident of the town of Cape Vincent, occurred at the home of Joseph Bisnette, Mud Creek, Tuesday morning at ten o'clock. The funeral will be held from the home of Mr. Bisnette Thursday morning, the Rev. Walter B. Cook officiating. The interment will be made at St. Lawrence. The Eagle hopes to give more complete particulars next week.

—William Watkins, whose death notice appeared in last week's Eagle, was the eldest son of William and Mahala Mead Watkins, and grandson of William and Ann Morgan Watkins, who came to the county of Jefferson in 1800 from Wales. He married Minerva McNitt in 1872, she dying in 1894. He had always lived in either the town of Lyme or Cape Vincent since his people moved here, when he was about ten years old. Politically he had always been a staunch Republican, and by faith Universalist. Although one of a family of ten but one, a half sister, survives him.
