ACCIDENT INJURIES PROVE FATAL

Major accident injuries proved fatal to Mrs. Minnie Weaver, 70, wife of Fred Weaver, Sandy Creek, R. D. She died on Sept. 21st, in Onondaga General hospital, from severe internal injuries suffered Sunday, Sept. 14 in an auto collision at Bassinger corners.

Mrs. Weaver was born Nov. 11, 1876, in the town of Boylston, daughter of Stephen and Naomi Blue Westcott. Her early life was spent in Sandy Creek where she was married to Mr. Weaver.

Most of her life was spent on a farm in the western part of the town. She was a member of the Sandy Creek Home Bureau and of the Universalist church of Watertown.

Mrs. Weaver is survived by her husband, also a patient at the Onondaga General hospital, due to injuries received in the same accident; two sons, Melvin Weaver, of Northern N. Y., and Maurice Weaver of Sandy Creek, and one brother, Daniel Westcott, Sandy Creek; one grandchild and one great grandchild.

The funeral will be held this afternoon at 2:00 at the family home, Rev. Niles of Watertown Universalist church, officiating.

Interment will be in Ellisburg cemetery.
