Bath—Wilmont Upson Webb, 63, died of heart disease at his home in Saranac Avenue, Buffalo, Monday. The body will be brought here for burial in Grove Cemetery Thursday. Mr. Webb was a native of Bath and passed his early life here, receiving his education under the late Dr. Levi D. Miller at Haverling Academy. He had been located more than 40 years in Buffalo where he was manager of an insurance company.
